Day 1: Welcome - Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts

Welcome to our nation's capital! Be sure to arrive at DCA airport by 4:30 pm to meet your Local Leader and catch the group transfer to your hotel. At check-in you will be given an information packet and welcome gifts. Enjoy a welcome dinner at The Point, where you will get to meet your group surrounded by panoramic views of the Potomac and Anacostia rivers. After dinner, return to the hotel for the evening to rest up for the days ahead! Accommodation at DoubleTree by Hilton Washington, D.C., Crystal City (or similar). (D)

Day 2: Capitol Buildings & Memorials

Get an early start this morning with the incredible educational experience, The People's House: A White House Experience. Explore exhibits detailing the history of the Executive Mansion and its inhabitants. After, you will head to the White House itself for a photo opportunity! After a visit to the National World War I Museum, you will arrive at Capitol Hill, where you can see the United States Capitol and enjoy lunch on your own at the Visitor Center Cafeteria. You will then visit the United States Library of Congress and tour the exterior of The Supreme Court Building. Spend the remainder of the afternoon visiting some of the most impactful memorials in Washington, D.C., including the Dwight D. Eisenhower Memorial, the Vietnam Veterans Memorial, the Lincoln Memorial and the Korean War Veterans Memorial. Enjoy dinner at Tony and Joe's Seafood, where you will enjoy a delicious meal and scenic river views. Finish the day with an Illuminated Monument Driving Tour to appreciate the beauty of the memorials and monuments by night. You will then stop at the National World War II Memorial and the Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts before returning to the hotel for the evening. (B, D)

Day 3: National Cherry Blossom Festival

Today is cherry blossom day! Be sure to try and wear pink to make the day extra festive. Set off in the morning for the National Cherry Blossom Festival Parade — be sure to bring your welcome gifts to cheer on the performers! After the parade, you will have free time at the Wharf to explore and enjoy lunch on your own. You will then enjoy a Cherry Blossom Cruise aboard the Odyssey III cruise ship. Enjoy a themed welcome drink and delicious food as you admire the city from the water. Back on land, enjoy a Pink Stroll along the beautiful Japanese cherry trees before visiting the Martin Luther King Jr., Franklin D. Roosevelt and Jefferson memorials. You will then stop at the Fashion Center at Pentagon City for dinner on your own before returning to the hotel for the evening. (B)

Day 4: Smithsonian Institution Museums

Today exemplifies all the incredible knowledge and information Washington, D.C., houses. Begin with a visit to the Air Force Memorial before heading to the National Mall and taking your pick of incredible museums! Note: Reservations at museums are not included. Perhaps explore the National Museum of National History or maybe opt for the Hirshhorn Museum and Sculpture Garden, just to name a couple. In the afternoon, continue to the National Archives to view the most impactful and significant documents of the United States of America. This evening, you will be brought to Old Town Alexandria to explore this historic area and enjoy dinner on your own at one of the many establishments along King Street. (B)

Day 5: Arlington and Mount Vernon

After breakfast set off for Arlington National Cemetery. Ride the tram through the significant locations including the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, the John F. Kennedy Eternal Flame and more. See the Changing of the Guard by the steps at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier before departing. Continue to Mount Vernon where you will have free time to get lunch on your own before embarking on a tour of the mansion! You will then visit the Ford Orientation Center and Donald W. Reynolds Museum and Education Center at Mount Vernon. In the evening, enjoy a final dinner with your group at Gadsby's Tavern, where you may even meet Martha Washington! (B, D)

Day 6: Departure

After breakfast and hotel checkout, transfer to DCA. Or, you can opt to take part in the final day's optional activities if you have a later flight.* You will first go to Embassy Row and drive by the Washington National Cathedral. You will then continue to the Hillwood Estate, Museum and Gardens. Enjoy some time exploring the grounds on your own and take in the beauty and history. Your Washington, D.C., adventure ends with a visit to the National Zoo! Take in this wonder as you traverse the 163 acres that are home to thousands of animals. Lunch will be on your own while at the zoo. The last group transfer will bring guests to DCA or return them to their hotel. (B)
